A FLORIDA-based entrepreneur, who was brought up in the Towy Valley, has hit the back of the net with a new football magazine.

Christopher Harris traded life in Llandeilo for the sunny climate of Florida back in 1984, when he was still a teenager.

And his move has paid off this month with the launch of the former Ffairfach pupil's EPL Talk Magazine.

The magazine is written exclusively for Premiership fans who follow the drama, passion and goals of the world's most popular club league.

Mr Harris returns often to the Towy Valley and recalls his childhood memories with great fondness.

"My childhood in Wales was a very formative time for me, especially in football terms," says the 36-year-old.

"I have many fond memories of playing football against the lads in the parks of Ffairfach and Llandeilo.

"I'll never forget travelling down to the Vetch to watch Swansea City rise from the fourth division to Division One. It was a magical time time in my life."

Harris's experience as a journalist and marketing professional also helped in writing and creating the EPL Talk Magazine, which is available as a free download from the website.

Football has been a common thread in Harris's life.

The father-of-two surprised his wife by proposing to her in front of 12,000 fans during half time at a soccer match in Miami.
